


Resolution in Loving Memory of Dr. Franklin Jay (F.J.) Pepper March 21, 1935 – Jan. 6, 2025

Whereas, Dr. Franklin Jay (F.J.) Pepper was an extremely intelligent, philosophical, analytical, and caring person;

Whereas, Dr. Franklin Jay (F.J.) Pepper was the devoted husband of former Alexandria City Councilor and Vice Mayor Del Pepper and the loving father of Murphy;

Whereas, Dr. Franklin Jay (F.J.) Pepper served in the United States Army Medical Corps as a captain from 1966 to 1968 and was awarded a Bronze Star- "M", Combat Medical Badge, Air Medal.;

Whereas, Dr. Franklin Jay (F.J.) Pepper was a prominent psychiatrist for more than sixty (60) years and had lived in Alexandria Virginia since 1968;

Whereas, Dr. Franklin Jay (F.J.) Pepper was a lifetime member and honoree of the NAACP, a former President of the Alexandria NAACP and a member of twenty-eight (28) Masonic organizations;
